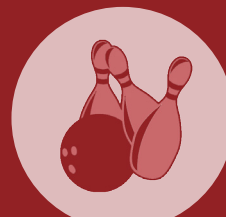

The Briggs Family

Judy and Dale Briggs are long time supporters and friends of OPARC. Mary H. Boyd, one of OPARC’s founders, first introduced Judy to OPARC more than thirty years ago. Mary called Judy and asked her to come visit OPARC to see first-hand how the great programs and services were transforming lives of adults with disabilities.

One phone call and a personal visit to OPARC led to a long time friendship. Judy spent countless hours volunteering at OPARC, serving on special committees and eventually became a member of the board of directors also serving as board president.

One of Judy’s most memorable moments was the groundbreaking ceremony for OPARC’s facility in Montclair on September 26, 2003. She distinctly remembers the outpouring of support from the community and OPARC participants. She recalls one participant who donated aluminum cans he had collected to help raise money for the new building.

One special fundraiser was a breakfast where people could “buy a door”. By making a donation, your name would be placed next to one of the doors in the new building. Today, as you walk down the halls of the OPARC offices, you see the names of those who made a donation that helped build the new facility.

At the center of the building’s interior on the second floor there is a very special room, the Briggs Room. This multi-use space overlooks the employment activity area and is used for meetings, conferences, staff events, and more. It is forever dedicated to the Briggs family in recognition of their support and friendship with OPARC.

Judy & Dale continue to be vital supporters of OPARC and are members of the Leadership Circle, in recognition of their lifetime giving.

Each day OPARC spends between \$50-75 to provide life-transforming services to the nearly 900 clients that walk through our doors. The state reimbursement covers only 70% of this expense.

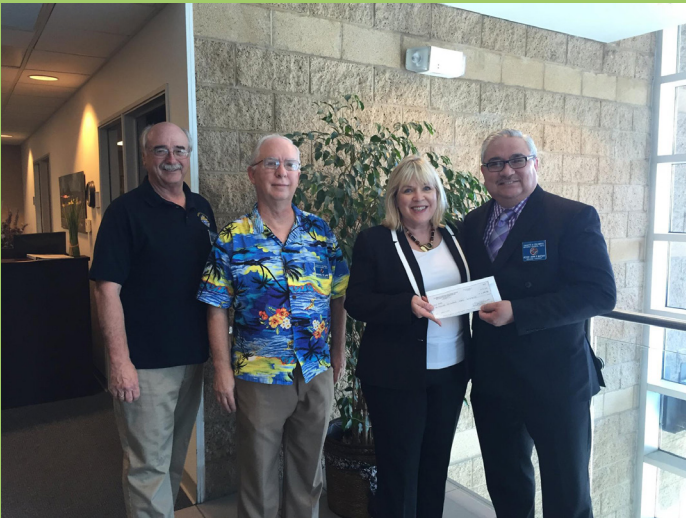
Knights of Columbus – Ontario
