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



Eliseo, A Face of Inspiration

When Simpson Strong-Tie started working with OPARC's Paid Internship Program in September 2017, Eliseo was their first paid intern. He began as a Day Porter performing vital services during business hours to keep the building running smoothly, such as cleaning and maintaining common areas (lobbies, kitchens, cafeterias, and patios) and monitoring and servicing restrooms. Eliseo worked a four-hour shift cleaning parts of Simpson Strong-Tie's 400,000-square-foot building and was able to complete all his tasks with time to spare.

Eliseo performed so admirably during his internship, the company wanted to keep him! On June 1, Simpson Strong-Tie hired Eliseo, increased his schedule to a five-hour workday, and gave him additional responsibilities. Now, once his Day Porter tasks are complete, he takes over janitorial services and performs online trainings, giving him new computer skills.

Dana has seen that Eliseo takes constructive criticism very well and is eager to improve. Whenever he encounters roadblocks or challenges, his Simpson Strong-Tie team and his OPARC team work together to troubleshoot and help Eliseo make changes to improve his workflow. Dana said, "The OPARC Paid Internship Program partnership opportunity was offered to me to take on, and I jumped on it. I wanted to find ways to engage OPARC clients; it has become a passion. And to incorporate it into our company that values giving back just makes it that much more meaningful because I know I will have the support to keep this partnership moving forward."

As for Eliseo, when asked how he feels about working for Simpson Strong-Tie, he said, "I like it" and when they offered him the job, he said he "did not hesitate. I think I was ready." He said his favorite thing about working with Simpson Strong-Tie is "the people and the food" because they get fed a lot through events and monthly birthday celebrations, and if he sees himself working with Simpson Strong-Tie for a long time, he said "Yes!"
